Articles of Incorporation

Article 4

The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). Specifically, the corporation is organized to (a) support the education of the community about sustainable agriculture and local commerce, (b) to lessen the burden on the local government through programs which bring affordable, local produce to the underprivileged (e.g. EBT programs) and support local commerce and tourism, (c) lessen neighborhood tensions through fostering community relations, and (d) combating community deterioration through the support of local commerce especially local farmers.

In pursuance of these purposes it shall have the powers to carry on any business or other activity which may be lawfully conducted by a corporation organized under the Washington Nonstock Corporations Act, whether or not related to the foregoing purposes, and to do all things necessary, proper, and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under IRC Section 501(c)(3).

Article 5

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of IRC Section 501(c)(3) or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
